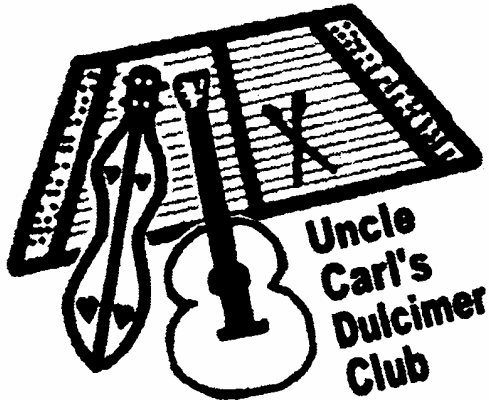
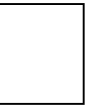
Thanks to all our members who played at the Grosvenor Museum.
